

March 26, 2011 Algansee Township Annual Meeting

A. Saturday, March 26, 2011 the Algansee Township Board held its Annual Meeting at the Algansee Township Hall, 378 South Ray Quincy Road, Quincy, Michigan. Supervisor Tom Morgan called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with board members present- Supervisor Tom Morgan, Treasurer Ann Strong, Trustee Bill Avra, Trustee Mick Belcher and Clerk Suzanne Preston. The visitors present were John Shilling and Suzanne Morgan.

Pledge to the Flag- Suzanne Preston led us in the pledge to the American flag.

B. Public Comment- John Shilling mentioned that the trees by the township hall mailbox need to be cut down and wondered what equipment is on the internet tower since it was originally constructed. Supervisor Tom Morgan said he would ask Dave from DMCI to come to a township meeting to explain everything on the internet tower. John Shilling said he asked Sam Girod about putting a hitching rail at the township hall. Sam said he would do it as soon as he buys a piece of pipe. Bill Avra said he has pipe that could be used for the hitching rail and he will go and speak to Sam about it.

C. Minutes- Ann Strong motioned to accept the minutes of the March 27, 2010 Annual Meeting. Bill Avra supported the motion. Motion carried.

D. Treasurer's Report- Treasurer Ann Strong reported last year's Annual Meeting balance was \$424,994.81 and this year's Annual Meeting balance is \$388,239.41. The Clerk agrees. Mick Belcher motioned to accept the Treasurer's report. Support by Bill Avra. Motion carried.

E. Banking Institutions- Ann Strong motioned to have Flag Star, PNC, Century Bank and Trust, Monarch Community Bank, Southern Michigan National Bank, Sturgis Savings and Loan as the township's banking institutions. Suzanne Preston supported the motion. Motion carried.

F. Adoption of the 2011-2012 Annual Budget- Bill Avra motioned to approve the 2011-2012 Annual Budget. Support by Mick Belcher. Motion carried.

G. Meeting Dates- Suzanne Preston motioned to hold the township monthly meetings on the first Monday night of every month at 7:30pm; unless it is a holiday or a sheriff declared emergency and then it will be held the next night. Ann Strong supported the motion. Motion carried.

H. Public Comment- John Shilling said he thought the roads in the township have held up well this winter. Ann Strong said Lester Road hasn't.

I. Adjourn- Mick Belcher motioned to adjourn. Ann Strong supported the motion. Motion carried. Adjourn at 9:20 a.m.
