

Alganssee Township Planning Commission October 26, 2015 Minutes

1. On Monday, October 26, 2015 at 7:30 pm Chairman Rodney Carpenter called the regular meeting of the Alganssee Township Planning Commission meeting to order at the Alganssee Township Hall, 378 South Ray-Quincy Rd., Quincy, MI. Members present were: Chairman Rodney Carpenter, Vice Chairman Pricilla Dodd, Township Representative John Shilling and Secretary, Glenn Preston. Rick Coon was absent.

Chairman Rodney Carpenter reported Cherie Cochrane resigned as the recording secretary of the Alganssee Planning Commission.

2. Minutes: The August 31, 2015 and the September 28, 2015 Alganssee Planning Commission meeting minutes were discussed. 6. Report from Zoning Administrator: Amos Barnett reported he issued 3 zoning permits for the month of September- Sam Schwartz, Jerry Snellenburger and Preston Farms. Amos Barnett reported he received a call from Larry Parks that his place at 556 Ray Quincy Road that the calves are out of his barn.

Jamie Wietecki asked if Zoning Administrator Amos Barnett had issued a zoning permit for a 2 car garage or a 10 x 20 shed on Bennett Drive. Amos said he would check on it.

7. Report from Zoning Board of Appeals Representative: They did not meet.

8. New Business: Zoning Administrator Amos Barnett reported Charlie Hoopes is requesting a public hearing for the November meeting. Supervisor Russ Jennings reported on the Branch County Supervisors meeting and it was discussed there will be changes to the Medical marijuana law soon. Supervisor Russ Jennings reported the meeting between the Branch County Road Commission, the Branch County Farm Bureau, Sheriff John Pollack, the State Representatives and the Amish will try to meet in November when everyone can come.
