What is the Friends of the Alganssee Library?

The Friends group provides support to the Alganssee Library, which is a branch of the Branch District Library system, through helping to purchase items such as: craft supplies, books, and programming materials. They also host programs and assist the librarian with various activities.

The Friends Group began on April 10, 2001 with 6 members. In June 2001, we began the process of formalizing the group by applying for a Federal ID number and becoming a 501(c)3 non-profit

organization. The Friends received their preliminary 501(c)3 status on April 15, 2002; our formal approval was received on February 11, 2006.

The Friends Group does a number of fundraisers including a book sale in the spring and fall with proceeds going toward summer reading prizes.

Any donations received by the Friends Group are tax deductible and go directly back to programs, supplies, promotional materials, and books to be used for the library.

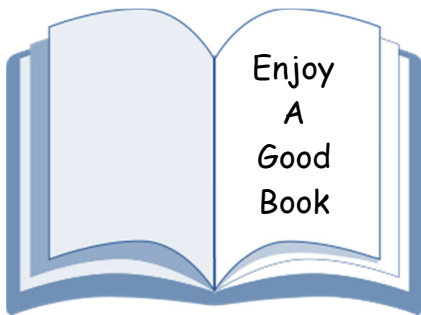
Friends of the Algansee Library Fair 2017 Newsletter

All you need is a library card to use the following services via any computer, laptop, tablet, or phone at the library or at home. Wi-Fi is available at the library after hours as well. If you don't have a library card stop at the Algansee Library and Jan and Jessie will get you set up with one.

Hoopla -- Allows you to instantly borrow free digital movies, music, and more, 24/7 with your library card. All you need to do is download the app or go to hoopladigital.com and log in with your library card.

Overdrive – Allows you to download Audio and E-books by going to woodlands/overdrive.com or clicking on the “O” icon on the library website.

America’s News Bank -- Full text articles from hundreds of newspapers from Michigan and across the United States as well as news magazines. The newspapers are published one day later then you would get them at the newsstand. Please see the link on the Library website to log in “NB”.

Mango – Language instruction – Need help learning another language log into this link “m”.
