

Options for Voter Registration or updating your address:

Those who have a **valid Michigan Driver's License or State ID**, can register at www.Michigan.gov/VOTE.

If there are **15+ days** before an election, voters can register online, by mail, or in person.

Within 14 days of an election, and on Election Day, voters may only register by visiting their local clerk's office to register in person with proof of residency documentation.

Will you be away from home during an election and have joined the Absentee Voter Permanent Ballot List?

Ballots are sent to your residential address. They do not forward. If you are temporarily away and need your ballot sent to a different address, please contact the Twp. Clerk's office at least 60 days before the election.

75 days before election

Ballots available:

45 days before election

Applying by mail:

It is recommended to submit your application at least 2 weeks prior to election.

Applying in person:

Ends at 4:00 p.m. on the day before election.

ABSENTEE

Any registered voter can vote an absentee ballot.

There are 2 steps to this process:

1) Submit a ballot application.

This is not required if you have already joined the Absentee Voter Permanent Ballot List.

Absentee Application Options:

- Online at www.Michigan.gov/VOTE
- Email or call from the Twp. Clerk's office
- Visit the Twp. Clerk's office

2) Return your voted ballot

by mail, by bringing to the township office, or by placing in the absentee ballot drop box located at the township office.

BALLOTS MUST ARRIVE AT TWP. CLERK'S OFFICE BEFORE 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY.

Returning your ballot to the township office or to the township drop box is strongly recommended, instead of mailing, especially in the last week prior to the election.

DON'T FORGET—THE OUTSIDE OF THE BALLOT ENVELOPE MUST BE SIGNED BY THE VOTER!

VOTING METHOD #2 IN PERSON - EARLY VOTING ✓

Registered voters can vote during the 9 day Early Voting period for **ALL STATE & FEDERAL ELECTIONS**. **The Early Voting period is the second Saturday prior to election day thru the last Sunday prior to election day.**
